She founded the famous international Ramatuelle Festival of Theatre and also founded several international Festivals, and Chairman of Figures of Peace, an international association promoting the photos of living Nobel Peace Prize Winners. She produced several films on the theatre and authored several books and catalogues. She has great international experience in Africa, Asia and Latin America and received several distinctions (Commander of Arts and Letters, Officer of National Merit, Officer of the Legion of Honour) from the French Government. She is a board member of Vranken Pommery and Lucas Carton.-----

WHO IS SHAMSA SALEH : Shamsa Saleh began her career with Dubai Women Establishment in 2008, rising up the ranks from Director of Strategic Planning & Corporate Development to Chief Executive Officer in 2011.
